Classified Credential Grant Goal:

The Classified Employee Teacher Credentialing grant is a state-funded career ladder program leading to a teaching credential.

- Classified staff who are interested in enrolling in a teacher credentialing program
- Candidate interests must match the district's areas of highest need, i.e. Special Education (SPED), Early Childhood Education, Bilingual Authorization, Math, Science, English
- Partnerships with CSULB & CSUDH
- Up to 30 participants over the life of the grant
- \$4,800 per year per participant (2 years of funding for selected candidates who meet the eligibility requirements for reimbursement, may be extended to 3 years dependent upon funding).

LBUSD Application Components

- LBUSD Classified Employee
- Google Form
- Cover Letter
- Transcripts (note GPA requirements for CSULB/CSUDH)
- Proof of passing CBEST/CSET (if available)
- Supervisor Recommendation (deployed upon receipt of application)
- Short video answering the question: Describe what made you decide to become a teacher and how will you commit to LBUSD students?

Application Due Dates:

4/9: Grant Application Due to LBUSD

6/1: Fall Deadline for 2024 CSUDH & CSULB

*Two university applications are required. One application is for admission to the university, the other is for admission to the credential program.

Participant Commitments

Selected participants will be asked to agree to the following:

- If selected, complete application to CSUDH or CSULB
- Complete all of the requirements for, and obtain, a bachelor's degree and/or Bilingual Authorization, Education Specialist, Single Subject (Math, Science, or English) Credential
- If offered a position in the LBUSD, teach in the district for one year for every year of the grant
